The manual must also detail the required training for the contractor, engineer, or architect 2.5 using the manual. All master design manuals must be peer 26 reviewed by an independent licensed engineer or architect 27 having no financial interest in the development of the manual 28 29 or the construction of structures pursuant to the manual. The engineer or architect conducting the peer review must be 30 identified in the manual.
