A bill to be entitled

An act relating to safety at school bus stops;  
requiring each school district to have a plan  
to improve safety at school bus stops;  
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Each school district shall have a plan to  
improve safety at school bus stops in the district.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN  
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
SB 428

The committee substitute eliminates the original bill's  
requirement that the Department of Education assess school bus  
stop safety; rather, school districts must develop a school  
bus stop safety plan. The committee substitute also eliminates  
the requirement for school districts to report bus stop safety  
information to the Department of Education.
