Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, line 29, through
page 2, line 16, delete those lines

and insert: this state; and

(c) Submits to the state university or the community
college the DD-214 form issued at the time of separation from
service as documentation that the student has received a
Purple Heart or another combat decoration superior in
precedence.

Such a waiver for a Purple Heart recipient or recipient of
another combat decoration superior in precedence shall be
applicable for 110 percent of the number of required credit
hours of the degree or certificate program for which the
student is enrolled. If such a student has an outstanding
undergraduate student loan that was awarded before receipt of
the combat decoration, the Department of Education shall pay

1 the balance due on the student loan as of the date that the
 2 tuition waiver was first granted once the repayment of the
 3 loan is considered to be in good standing.
