A bill to be entitled

An act relating to safety belt law enforcement;
creating the Dori Slosberg and Katie Marchetti
Safety Belt Law; amending s. 316.614, F.S.;
deleting a requirement for enforcement of the
Florida Safety Belt Law as a secondary action;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Dori Slosberg
and Katie Marchetti Safety Belt Law."

Section 2. Subsection (8) of section 316.614, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

316.614 Safety belt usage.--

(8) Any person who violates the provisions of this
section commits a nonmoving violation, punishable as provided
in chapter 318. ~~However, except for violations of s. 316.613
and paragraph (4)(a), enforcement of this section by state or
local law enforcement agencies must be accomplished only as a
secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been
detained for a suspected violation of another section of this
chapter, chapter 320, or chapter 322.~~

Section 3. This act shall take effect June 30, 2007.
