22	school student in any vocational or career education course or

29	college the DD-214 form issued at the time of separation from
30	service or military orders or other documentation issued

33	Such a waiver shall be applicable for 110 percent of the number
34	of required credit hours of the degree or certificate program
35	for which the student is enrolled.
