8 (3) Notwithstanding any provision of local law, for any
9 municipality in which an election is scheduled to be held in
10 March 2008, the governing body of the municipality,
11 notwithstanding any municipal charter provision, may, by
12 ordinance, move the date of the general municipal election in
13 2008 and in each subsequent year that is a multiple of 4 to the
14 date during the respective year concurrent with the presidential
15 preference primary. The dates for qualifying for the general
16 municipal election moved by the passage of such an ordinance

18 run for no less than 14 days. The term of office for any
