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The Committee on Governmental Operations (Posey) recommended the following **amendment to amendment** (275140):

**Senate Amendment (with directory and title amendments)**

On page 1, line 17, through page 2, line 16, delete those lines

and insert: than 50 percent of the land in such area, excluding state-owned land, consent to such annexation. Such consent shall be obtained by the parties proposing the annexation prior to the referendum to be held on the annexation. The municipality may not annex state-owned land if the state objects to the proposed annexation; however, if the state does not object, the acreage of state-owned land shall not be considered when calculating the owners of more than 50 percent of the land who must, under this subsection, consent to the annexation. State-owned land that is annexed under this subsection is not subject to ordinances or land use designations that preclude any use of the state-owned land which is consistent or compatible with the purposes for which the state-owned land was acquired, the management plan
