2007 A bill to be entitled An act relating to cardrooms; amending s. 849.086, F.S.; providing definitions; authorizing cardroom operators to host high-stakes poker tournaments and high-stakes dominoes tournaments at certain pari-mutuel facilities; providing limitations; providing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 849.086, Florida Statutes, is amended, present subsections (9) through (17) of that section are redesignated as subsections (11) through (19), respectively, and new subsections (9) and (10) are added to that section, to read: 849.086 Cardrooms authorized.--DEFINITIONS.--As used in this section: (2)(a) "Authorized game" means a game or series of games of poker which are played in a nonbanking manner. (b) "Banking game" means a game in which the house is a participant in the game, taking on players, paying winners, and collecting from losers or in which the cardroom establishes a bank against which participants play. (C) "Cardroom" means a facility where authorized card games are played for money or anything of value and to which the public is invited to participate in such games and charged a fee for participation by the operator of such facility. Authorized games and cardrooms do not constitute casino gaming operations. "Cardroom management company" means any individual not (d)

an employee of the cardroom operator, any proprietorship, partnership, corporation, or other entity that enters into an agreement with a cardroom operator to manage, operate, or otherwise control the daily operation of a cardroom.

(e) "Cardroom distributor" means any business that distributes cardroom paraphernalia such as card tables, betting chips, chip holders, drop boxes, banking supplies, playing cards, card shufflers, and other associated equipment to authorized cardrooms.

(f) "Cardroom operator" means a licensed pari-mutuel permitholder which holds a valid permit and license issued by the division pursuant to chapter 550 and which also holds a valid cardroom license issued by the division pursuant to this section which authorizes such person to operate a cardroom and to conduct authorized games in such cardroom.

(g) "Division" means the Division of Pari-mutuel Wageringof the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

46 (h) "Dominoes" means flat rectangular blocks the faces of 47 which are divided into two equal parts that are blank or include 48 from one to six dots arranged in a pattern.

(i) "High-stakes dominoes" means a game of dominoes which is played using a set of 28 dominoes and without limits on the amount wagered in any game or series of games or without limits on the rounds of betting.

53 <u>(j)(h)</u> "Gross receipts" means the total amount of money 54 received by a cardroom from any person for participation in 55 authorized games.

Such a tournament may be conducted only 82 once in any 6-month period.

83 (10) HIGH-STAKES DOMINOES TOURNAMENTS.--A cardroom
84 operator may host a high-stakes dominoes tournament twice each
