The Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 (Wise) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause

and insert:

Section 1. (1) No later than January 1, 2008, the Department of Health shall adopt a rule adding the human papillomavirus to the list of communicable diseases for which immunizations are recommended.

(2) Beginning with the 2008-2009 school year, the parent or guardian of each public and private school student entering grade 6 for whom the human papillomavirus vaccine is approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration, must be provided information by the school concerning the connection between the human papillomavirus and cervical cancer and that a vaccine that helps prevent human papillomavirus infection is available and recommended to be given to females before they enter grade 6.

(3) The information required to be provided to the

 3 prescribed by the Department of Health.
