2007 House Joint Resolution A joint resolution proposing the amendment of Section 4 of Article IV and Section 2 of Article IX and the creation of Section 27 of Article XII of the State Constitution to create the position of Commissioner of Education, who will be an elected member of the Cabinet, and to provide an effective date and for filling the initial term for the office of Commissioner of Education. Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: That the following amendment of Section 4 of Article IV and Section 2 of Article IX and the creation of Section 27 of Article XII of the State Constitution are agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose: ARTICLE IV EXECUTIVE Cabinet. --SECTION 4. There shall be a cabinet composed of an attorney (a) general, a chief financial officer, and a commissioner of agriculture, and a commissioner of education. In addition to the powers and duties specified herein, they shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as may be prescribed by law. In the event of a tie vote of the governor and cabinet, the side on which the governor voted shall be deemed to prevail. The attorney general shall be the chief state legal (b) Page 1 of 4

officer. There is created in the office of the attorney general 29 30 the position of statewide prosecutor. The statewide prosecutor shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the state attorneys to 31 prosecute violations of criminal laws occurring or having 32 occurred, in two or more judicial circuits as part of a related 33 transaction, or when any such offense is affecting or has 34 35 affected two or more judicial circuits as provided by general law. The statewide prosecutor shall be appointed by the attorney 36 37 general from not fewer less than three persons nominated by the judicial nominating commission for the supreme court, or as 38 otherwise provided by general law. 39

40 (c) The chief financial officer shall serve as the chief
41 fiscal officer of the state, and shall settle and approve
42 accounts against the state, and shall keep all state funds and

(d) The commissioner of agriculture shall have supervision
