7 millage rate equal to the rolled-back rate as defined in s.  
8 200.065 and shall remain frozen until the Taxation and Budget  
9 Reform Commission places a tax relief and reform measure on the  
10 ballot which becomes a part of the State Constitution.

11 (b) This subsection does not apply to taxing authorities  
12 that have levied ad valorem taxes for 5 years or less.

13 (2) (a) For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2007, ad  
14 valorem taxes may not be levied in excess of the maximum millage  
15 rate that would have resulted from application of subsection (1)  
16 if subsection (1) had been in effect beginning January 1, 2005,
