The term "covered policy" includes any collateral protection insurance 3 policy covering personal residences which protects both the borrower's and the lender's financial interests, in an amount 5 at least equal to the coverage for the dwelling in place under 7 the lapsed homeowner's policy, if such policy can be accurately reported as required in subsection (5). 8 Additionally, covered policies include policies covering the 10 peril of wind removed from the Florida Residential Property 11 and Casualty Joint Underwriting Association or from the Citizens Property Insurance Corporation, created under 12 13 pursuant to s. 627.351(6), or from the Florida Windstorm Underwriting Association, created under pursuant to s. 14 15 627.351(2), by an authorized insurer under the terms and 16 conditions of an executed assumption agreement between the authorized insurer and such association or Citizens Property 17 18 Insurance Corporation. Each assumption agreement between the 19 association and such authorized insurer or Citizens Property 20 Insurance Corporation must be approved by the Office of 21 Insurance Regulation before prior to the effective date of the 22 assumption, and the Office of Insurance Regulation must provide written notification to the board within 15 working 23 24 days after such approval.
