Section 2. Subsection (13) of section 112.313, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

112.313 Standards of conduct for public officers, employees of agencies, and local government attorneys.--

(13) COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES AND SPECIAL DISTRICT AND SCHOOL DISTRICT RESOLUTIONS REGULATING FORMER OFFICERS OR EMPLOYEES.--

The governing body of any county or municipality may adopt an ordinance and the governing body of any special district or school district may adopt a resolution providing that an appointed county, municipal, special district, or school district officer or a county, municipal, special district, or school district employee may not personally represent another person or entity for compensation before the

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1 government body or agency of which the individual was an
 2 officer or employee for a period of 2 years following vacation
 3 of office or termination of employment, except for the
 4 purposes of collective bargaining. ~~Nothing in~~ This section
 5 does not ~~may be construed to~~ prohibit such ordinance or
