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CHARTER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION TRANSIT SYSTEM SURTAX.--(1)Each charter county that has which adopted a charter 21 (a) prior to January 1, 1984, and each county the government of 22 which is consolidated with that of one or more municipalities, 23 may levy a discretionary sales surtax, subject to approval by a 24 25 majority vote of the electorate of the county or by a charter amendment approved by a majority vote of the electorate of the 26 27 county.

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(b) The rate shall be up to 1 percent.

The proposal to adopt a discretionary sales surtax as 29 (C) provided in this subsection and to create a trust fund within 30 the county accounts shall be placed on the ballot in accordance 31 with law at a time to be set at the discretion of the governing 32 33 body.

34 (d) Proceeds from the surtax shall be applied to as many or as few of the uses enumerated below in whatever combination 35 the county commission deems appropriate: 36
