## Amendment

Remove lines 231-272 and insert:

Sunset Commission Committee on Sunset Review shall be phased out and abolished in accordance with this section if the conditions set forth in subsection (2) or subsection (3) have been met by June 30 following the date of review specified in s. 11.905. abolished on June 30 following the date of review specified in s. 11.905, unless the Legislature continues the agency or advisory committee; however, an agency may not be abolished unless the Legislature finds, pursuant to law, that all state laws the agency had responsibility to implement or enforce have been repealed, revised, or reassigned to another remaining agency and

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- (2) If the Legislature has failed to reenact the agency prior to June 30 following the date of review specified in s.

  11.905, then the agency shall be required to begin restricting its operations subject to a phased-in dissolution schedule.

  During the phased-in dissolution schedule, the agency shall continue its activities, programs, and operations except that its future legislative budget requests shall be submitted to reflect an annual reduction of 25 percent of its current year budget, with a total budget elimination in 4 years. Such agency shall continue to be subject to sunset review by the commission until the Legislature enacts legislation relating to its continuation, modification, or abolishment; or
- (3) (a) If the Legislature passes a law prior to June 30 following the date of review specified in s. 11.905 under which a substantial portion of the agency's responsibilities are reassigned or eliminated, then the agency shall be abolished provided that adequate provision has been made for the transfer to a successor agency of all duties and obligations relating to bonds, loans, promissory notes, lease-purchase lease purchase agreements, installment sales contracts, certificates of participation, master equipment financing agreements, or any other form of indebtedness such that security therefor and the rights of bondholders or holders of other indebtedness are not impaired.
- (b) All outstanding responsibilities of an abolished agency to implement or enforce state laws shall be continued or reassigned by the Governor by executive order within a reasonable time unless and until such responsibilities are 122273

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continued or reassigned by general law. These responsibilities include, but are not limited to, all duties and obligations relating to bonds, loans, promissory notes, lease-purchase agreements, installment sales contracts, certificates of participation, master equipment financing agreements, or any other form of indebtedness such that security therefor and the rights of bondholders or holders of other indebtedness are not impaired, unless and until such provision shall be made by general law. Any agency responsibilities that continue to operate under an executive order by the Governor shall continue to be subject to sunset review by the commission.

(2) If the Legislature does not take action before the date of review to continue the agency or advisory committee, the agency shall submit its legislative budget request consistent with recommendations of the appropriate Legislative Committee on Sunset Review or any law transferring the agency's functions to other entities.
