46	date of the agency's abolition. Such executive order shall
47	remain in effect unless and until such responsibilities are

50	obligations relating to bonds, loans, promissory notes, lease-
51	purchase agreements, installment sales contracts, certificates
52	of participation, master equipment financing agreements, or any
53	other form of indebtedness such that security therefor and the
54	rights of bondholders or holders of other indebtedness are not
55	impaired, unless and until such provision shall be made by
56	general law. Any agency responsibilities that continue to
57	operate under an executive order by the Governor shall continue
