100 WHEREAS, due to the severity of her injuries, Ms. Graham 101 cannot maintain employment and will require future medical care 102 over her lifetime and an additional surgery to remove the 103 hardware that was placed in her pelvis and iliosacral joint, and 104 WHEREAS, Ms. Graham's medical expenses resulting from this 105 accident were \$266,462.44 and the Palm Beach County Health Care

106 District has paid a portion of the outstanding medical expenses, 107 but has imposed a lien in the amount of \$87,937.31, and

WHEREAS, the present value of Ms. Graham's total economic damages over her lifetime was calculated to be \$1,018,988.40; however, the expert economist hired by the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office calculated the value to be \$771,670, and
