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The Committee on Ethics and Elections (Justice) recommended
the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 2, line 7 through,
page 3, line 3, delete those lines

and insert:

(2) A local government or a person acting on behalf of
local government may not expend or authorize the expenditure
of, and a person or group may not accept, public funds for a
political advertisement or electioneering communication
concerning an issue, referendum, or amendment that is subject
to a vote of the electors. This subsection does not apply to
an electioneering communication from a local government or a
person acting on behalf of a local government which is limited
to factual information.

(3) Except as prohibited in subsection (2), nothing in
this section precludes an elected official of the local
government from expressing an opinion on any issue at any
time.
