A bill to be entitled

An act relating to trespass on commercial premises; creating s. 810.091, F.S.; providing that a person may not remain on commercial premises held open to the public following an order to leave on specified grounds; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 810.091, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

810.091 Trespass on commercial premises.--For purposes of s. 810.08 or s. 810.09, a person may not lawfully remain on any property or in any structure that is held open to the public generally for commercial purposes after the owner or the owner's agent orders the person to leave the premises on the ground that the person is engaged in activity deemed by the owner or the owner's agent to be detrimental to the commercial purposes for which the premises is held open to the public.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
