21 Section 3. (1) Each year, the Department of Health
 22 shall analyze the results of the physician survey required by
 23 section 2 of this act and determine by geographic area and
 24 specialty the number of physicians who:

25 (a) Perform deliveries of children in Florida.

26 (b) Read mammograms and perform breast-imaging-guided
 27 procedures in Florida.

28 (c) Perform emergency care on a on-call basis for a
 29 hospital emergency department.

30 (d) Plan to reduce or increase emergency on-call hours
 31 in a hospital emergency department.

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1 (e) Plan to relocate their allopathic or osteopathic
2 practice outside the state.

3 (2) The Department of Health must report its findings
4 to the Governor, the President of Senate, and the Speaker of
5 the House of Representatives by November 1 each year.

6 Section 4. It is the intent of the Legislature that
7 the Department of Health implement the provisions of this act
8 within existing resources.
