Clemency.--19 (a) Except in cases of treason and in cases where 20 21 impeachment results in conviction, and except as otherwise 22 prescribed by law, the governor may, by executive order filed with the custodian of state records, suspend collection of 23 fines and forfeitures, grant reprieves not exceeding sixty 2.4 days and, with the approval of two members of the cabinet, 25 grant full or conditional pardons, restore civil rights, 26 27 commute punishment, and remit fines and forfeitures for 28 offenses. (b) In cases of treason the governor may grant 29 reprieves until adjournment of the regular session of the 30 legislature convening next after the conviction, at which 31 1

1 session the legislature may grant a pardon or further reprieve; otherwise the sentence shall be executed. 2 3 (c) There may be created by law a parole and probation 4 commission with power to supervise persons on probation and to 5 grant paroles or conditional releases to persons under 6 sentences for crime. The qualifications, method of selection 7 and terms, not to exceed six years, of members of the 8 commission shall be prescribed by law. 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be 10 placed on the ballot: 11 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT 12 ARTICLE IV, SECTION 8 13 RESTORATION OF CIVIL RIGHTS. -- Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution authorizing the Legislature to provide 14 15 the conditions under which fines and forfeitures may be suspended or remitted, reprieves may be granted, civil rights 16 17 may be restored, and punishments may be commuted. 18 19 20 21 22 23 2.4 25 26 27 28 29 30 31
