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(2) A pharmacist may not interchange an anti-epileptic
drug or formulation of an anti-epileptic drug, brand or generic
for the treatment of seizures or epilepsy without prior
notification and the signed informed consent of such interchange
from the prescribing physician and patient, or patient's parent
legal guardian, or spouse of the patient's parent or legal
guardian.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
