A bill to be entitled

An act relating to display of United States flags; providing a short title; creating ss. 125.564 and 166.0481, F.S.; prohibiting a county or municipality from enacting or enforcing an ordinance or regulation that would prohibit the display of a United States flag by certain persons in a respectful manner or require a permit or payment of any fee to authorize such display; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Florida Flies the Flag Act."

Section 2. Section 125.564, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

125.564 United States flag display regulation.--No county shall enact or enforce any ordinance or regulation that would prohibit the display of a United States flag by a property owner or tenant in a respectful manner or require a permit or payment of any fee to authorize such display.

Section 3. Section 166.0481, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

166.0481 United States flag display regulation.--No municipality shall enact or enforce any ordinance or regulation that would prohibit the display of a United States flag by a property owner or tenant in a respectful manner or require a permit or payment of any fee to authorize such display.
