House Resolution

A resolution recognizing the accomplishments and contributions of Florida Atlantic University.

WHEREAS, Florida Atlantic University was created by the Florida Legislature in 1961 as the state's fifth public university, and

WHEREAS, since opening its doors to undergraduate and graduate students, Florida Atlantic University has consistently distinguished itself as a center of outstanding teaching, research, and public service, and

WHEREAS, Florida Atlantic University is currently serving more than 26,000 students on seven campuses strategically located along 150 miles of Florida's southeastern coastline, and

WHEREAS, Florida Atlantic University is developing rapidly as a center of medical education and biomedical research through partnerships with the Leonard M. Miller School of Medicine at the University of Miami, Boca Raton Community Hospital, The Scripps Research Institute, Torrey Pines Institute for Molecular Studies, the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, and other outstanding scientific organizations, and

WHEREAS, Florida Atlantic University is a major force of economic growth in southeast Florida, generating more than \$1.15 billion annually in economic activity, NOW, THEREFORE,
