The Gold Star license plate shall be issued only 64 65 to family members of a servicemember who resided in Florida at the time of the death of the servicemember. 66 67 To qualify for issuance of a Gold Star license plate, 2. the applicant must be directly related to a fallen servicemember 68 as spouse, legal mother or father, or stepparent who is 69 70 currently married to the mother or father of the fallen 71 servicemember. 72 3. A classification of "killed 78 in action" by the Department of Defense shall be prima facie 79 evidence that the servicemember was killed in action. 80 (b) The applicant must provide documentation of the fact that the servicemember was killed in action and proof of 81 82 relationship to the servicemember to the tax collector or license plate agent before being issued a Gold Star license 83 plate. The tax collector or license plate agent may waive the 84

86	actual knowledge of the family relationship and that the
