House Resolution

A resolution designating April 10, 2007, as "University of South Florida Day" in Tallahassee.

WHEREAS, the University of South Florida has more than 200,000 alumni living in all 50 states and 80,000 graduates living in the Tampa Bay area and serves its community in the areas of health, business, and the arts, particularly through social programs that seek to make the Tampa Bay area a safe and viable place to live, and

WHEREAS, the University of South Florida has a \$3.2 billion annual economic impact on the Tampa Bay area and has been classified in the top tier of research universities by the Carnegie Foundation, and

WHEREAS, the University of South Florida invests its resources in ways that mutually benefit the university and the community through collaborative interactions and related scholarships, which has produced more than 600,000 volunteer hours from students, faculty, and staff and more than \$22 million in pro bono health care and distinguished the university as the only Florida institution to have received the Carnegie Foundation classification for Community Engagement in Outreach and Partnerships, and

WHEREAS, the University of South Florida submitted a winning proposal to the Florida Technology, Research, and Scholarship Board, which awarded the university \$8 million to create the Florida Center of Excellence for Biomolecular Identification and Targeted Therapeutics, a true

That the University of South Florida is recognized for its excellence as an institution of higher learning and for its exemplary service to its students and the wider community and designates April 10, 2007, as "University of South Florida Day" in Tallahassee.
