House Resolution

A resolution designating April 12, 2007, as "Virtual Education Day" in Florida.

WHEREAS, the Florida Virtual Education Program is a quality accredited educational choice for Florida's students and is a permanent part of the public education system in the State of Florida, and

WHEREAS, founded in 1997 as a grant-based project between two Florida school districts, the Florida Virtual Education Program was created as a pilot program that led to Florida's first Internet-based public high school, and

WHEREAS, in 2006, the Florida Legislature passed legislation that removed the remaining vestiges of pilot status and made the entire Florida Virtual Education Program a permanent part of Florida's K-20 education system, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Virtual Education Program has grown phenomenally, allowing students to learn at any time, in any place, down any path, and at any pace, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Virtual Education Program now includes K-8 programs and three virtual education schools, including the Florida Virtual School, the Florida Virtual Academy, and Connections Academy, all of which serve the educational needs of thousands of Florida's students, and

WHEREAS, parents and students have expanded access to courses through the Florida Virtual Education Program, and school districts have options to ease overcrowding and to
