A resolution designating May 1-7, 2007, as "Physical Education and Sports Week" in Florida.

5 WHEREAS, physical activity reduces the risk of heart 6 disease, high blood pressure, and diabetes at all ages and is 7 necessary to support normal growth in children and essential to 8 the continuing health and well-being of all youth and adults, 9 and

10 WHEREAS, nationally, almost half of individuals age 12 11 through 21 and more than one-third of high school students do 12 not participate in vigorous physical activity on a regular 13 basis, and

WHEREAS, 60 million school-aged children and youth in the United States have the potential to acquire the knowledge, skills, and values that can lead to a lifetime of being physically active and living healthy, and

18 WHEREAS, in a report on physical activity and health, the 19 Surgeon General of the United States Public Health Service 20 verified that regular physical activity is associated with an 21 improved health-related quality of life, and

22 WHEREAS, Florida residents could improve the quality of 23 their lives through proper diet and exercise, NOW, THEREFORE, 24
