13	(a) The department shall develop a United States Marine
14	Corps license plate as provided in this section. The word
15	"Florida" must appear at the top center of the plate, and the
16	words "Marine Corps" must appear at the bottom center of the
17	plate. The United States Marine Corps logo, 3 inches in
18	diameter, must appear on the left side centered top to bottom of

20	(b) The department shall distribute the United States
21	Marine Corps license plate annual use fees <u>as provided in this</u>

23	1. The first \$50,000 collected annually shall be

Sixty-five percent Any additional fees collected 32 annually shall be distributed to deposited in the Marine Corps 33 Scholarship Foundation, Inc., successor to the USMC 34 35 Tag/Scholarship Fund, Inc., which shall use the fees to fund 36 scholarships and assist Marine Corps Junior ROTC and Young 37 Marine programs of this state. The foundation shall develop a 38 plan to distribute the funds to recipients nominated by 39 residents of the state to receive scholarships, and to the Marine Corps Junior ROTC and Young Marine programs in the state. 40 Section 2.
