amendment** (484436):

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 2, lines 26 through 29, delete those lines

and insert:

(4) Fines paid under this section shall be paid to the  
Department of Environmental Protection and deposited in the  
State Park Trust Fund. If a person who receives a citation  
elects to defend himself in court, the county small claims  
court for the county in which the violation occurred shall  
have jurisdiction. Court costs shall be determined by and  
paid to the court as ordered by the court. No person who  
receives a citation but fails to pay the fine, sign and accept  
a citation, appear in court, or comply with the court's order  
may enter any state park property until he has paid the fine,  
complied with the procedure, or complied with the order. The  
department may establish by rule the procedures for giving a  
citation, giving a notice of appearance in court, payment of

 2 amounts of fines for civil infractions up to \$1,000;
