A bill to be entitled
An act relating to state parks; providing
members of the Florida National Guard and
certain dependents of such members free
admission to state parks; requiring
presentation of an identification card as a
condition of free admission; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. A person who is a member of the Florida
National Guard, or the spouse or minor child of such a person,
may not be charged a fee for admission to a state park upon
presentation of a valid card that identifies the person as
being an active member of the Florida National Guard or a
dependent of such a member.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides a member of the Florida National Guard, or the
spouse and minor child of such member, free admission to
state parks.
