On page 27, between lines 19 and 20,

insert:

Section 22. Subsection (1) of section 101.573, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

101.573 Record of votes by precinct.--

(1) Within 35 ~~75~~ days after the date of a municipal
election or runoff, whichever occurs later, a presidential
preference primary, a primary election, a special election, or
a general election, the supervisor of elections shall file
with the Department of State precinct-level election results,
in an electronic format specified by the Department of State,
for that election cycle, ~~including any primary elections.~~
Precinct-level election results shall separately record for
each precinct all demographic data associated with each
precinct at book close for each election, individual vote
history, the returns of ballots cast at the precinct location,

1 ~~to which have been added~~ the returns of absentee ballots cast
2 by voters registered in the precinct, and the returns of early
3 ballots cast by voters registered in the precinct. The data
4 are required to be cross referenced by political party and

7 for the collection and reporting of such precinct-level
8 election results and vote history.
