19	Section 1. Section 1008.38, Florida Statutes, is amended

22	(1) The State Board of Education shall develop
23	articulation accountability measures which assess the status of
24	systemwide articulation processes authorized under s. 1007.23.
25	The State Board of Education shall establish an articulation
26	accountability process which at a minimum shall address:
27	(a)(1) The impact of articulation processes on ensuring
28	educational continuity and the orderly and unobstructed
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29 transition of students between public secondary and 30 postsecondary education systems and facilitating the transition 31 of students between the public and private sectors. (b) (2) The adequacy of preparation of public secondary 32 students to smoothly articulate to a public postsecondary 33 education, the workplace, or both institution. 34 35 (c) (c) (3) The effectiveness of articulated acceleration 36 mechanisms available to secondary students. 37 (d) (d) (4) The smooth transfer of community college associate in arts degree graduates to a state university. 38 (e) (5) An examination of degree requirements that exceed 39 the parameters of 60 credit hours for an associate degree and 40 120 hours for a baccalaureate degree in public postsecondary 41 42 programs. (f) (f) (6) The relationship between the College Level Academic 43 44 Skills Test Program and articulation to the upper division in public postsecondary institutions. 45 The State Board of Education shall establish a process 46 (2)47 for continual and uninterrupted review of newly proposed 48 secondary courses to ensure sufficient rigor and relevance to 49 workforce and postsecondary education and alignment to state 50 curriculum standards. The review of newly proposed secondary courses shall 51 (a) be the responsibility of a curriculum review committee whose 52 membership is approved by the board of directors of Workforce 53 54 Florida, Inc., as described in s. 445.004, and includes: Three certified high school guidance counselors 55 1. recommended by the Florida Association of Student Services 56

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57 Administrators. Three associate superintendents for curriculum and 58 2. instruction recommended by the Florida Association of District 59 60 School Superintendents. 3. Three workforce representatives recommended by the 61 62 Agency for Workforce Innovation. 63 Three admissions directors of postsecondary 4. institutions accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges 64 and Schools, representing both public and private institutions. 65 66 The Deputy Commissioner of Education responsible for 5. 67 curriculum and instruction. The submission and review of newly proposed courses 68 (b) shall be conducted electronically and each proposed course shall 69 70 be approved or denied within 60 days. All approved courses shall 71 be approved as core courses for high school graduation purposes 72 and shall be immediately added to the Course Code Directory and 73 eligible for funding through the FEFP the following fiscal year. 74 Approved courses shall also be reviewed and considered for 75 approval for dual enrollment credit. The Board of Governors and the Commissioner of Education shall recommend an annual deadline 76 77 for approval of new courses to be included for FEFP funding, 78 postsecondary admissions, and dual enrollment credit the 79 following academic year. The State Board of Education shall 80 establish an appeals process that requires a ruling by the Chancellor for Community Colleges and Workforce Education within 81 82 15 days. (C) The curriculum review committee must be established 83 84 and operational no later than September 1, 2007.

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
