A bill to be entitled

An act relating to public school physical education; amending s. 1003.455, F.S.; providing requirements for student participation in physical education; requiring review and revision of the Sunshine State Standards for physical education; amending s. 1012.98, F.S.; requiring the Department of Education to develop and school districts to provide a professional development program; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 1003.455, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

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1003.455 Physical education programs; assessment.--

It is the responsibility of each district school board

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to develop a physical education program that stresses physical fitness and encourages healthful, active lifestyles. Each district school board shall require all students in kindergarten

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through grade 5, and to encourage all students in grades 6 through prekindergarten through grade 12, to participate in

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physical education. Physical education shall consist of physical

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duration sufficient to provide a significant health benefit to

activities of at least a moderate intensity level and for a

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students, subject to the differing capabilities of students. All

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physical education programs and curricula must be reviewed by a

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certified physical education instructor.

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(2) Each district school board shall adopt a written physical education policy that details the school district's physical education program and expected program outcomes.

- (3) Each district school board shall require each kindergarten through grade 5 student to participate in physical education daily to consist of is encouraged to provide 150 minutes of physical education each week for students in kindergarten through grade 5 and shall encourage each student in grades 6 through 12 to participate in physical education for 225 minutes each week for students in grades 6 through 8.
- (4) The State Board of Education shall review and revise as necessary the Sunshine State Standards for physical education to ensure that the standards reflect state-of-the-art physical education philosophy and practice.
- Section 2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (4) of section 1012.98, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (d) and a new paragraph (c) is added to that subsection to read:
  - 1012.98 School Community Professional Development Act.--
- (4) The Department of Education, school districts, schools, community colleges, and state universities share the responsibilities described in this section. These responsibilities include the following:
- (c) The department shall develop and each school district shall provide a professional development program for physical education instructors, elementary and secondary school teachers whose responsibilities include teaching physical education classes, and developers of physical education curricula.
  - Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
