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Senator Geller moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 26, between lines 27 and 28,

insert:

Section 12. (1) An Impact Fee Study Commission shall be created by October 1, 2007, for the purpose of determining the extent to which local governments attempt to balance their respective budgets by excessively increasing impact fees in response to implementing the provisions of this act, and to make recommendations for additional statutory provisions that should be taken to ensure that local governments do not balance their respective budgets by increasing impact fees to excessive levels.

(2) The commission shall be comprised of nine members, appointed as follows:

- (a) Three members appointed by the Governor;
- (b) Two members appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (c) Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House

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1 of Representatives;

2 (d) One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
3 Senate; and

4 (e) One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
5 House of Representatives.

6 (3)(a) Members of the commission shall serve without
7 compensation, but are entitled to reimbursement for per diem
8 and travel expenses in accordance with s. 112.061, Florida
9 Statutes.

10 (b) The Department of Revenue shall provide to the
11 commission the necessary staff and administrative support.

12 (4) The commission shall hold three public meetings in
13 three different geographical areas of the state and shall
14 submit a final report and recommendations to the Governor, the
15 President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of
16 Representatives by January 15, 2008.
