The difference 30 between the new homestead property's just value and its assessed 31 value in the first year the homestead is established may not 32 exceed the difference between the previous homestead's just 33 value and its assessed value in the year of sale. In addition, 34 to be assessed as provided in this paragraph, the assessed value 35 36 of the new homestead must equal or exceed the assessed value of the previous homestead. Thereafter, the homestead shall be 37 38 assessed as provided herein.
