11 (d) The legislature shall appropriate sufficient state
12 revenues each year necessary to replace the loss of tax revenues
13 for public education due to the additional homestead exemptions,
14 tangible personal property exemptions, and reductions in
15 assessments for affordable housing and working waterfronts
16 provided by the 2008 amendments to this constitution. The

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17 legislature may not reduce any other education appropriations in
18 fulfillment of this requirement.
