WHEREAS, Mike Davis attended Ohio State University and in 1974 moved to Naples, Florida, where he became a successful businessman and community leader, and

WHEREAS, Mike Davis served in various capacities in numerous civic and governmental organizations such as the Collier County Planning Commission, Collier County Health Facilities Funding Authority, Naples Area Chamber of Commerce, Naples Bay Rotary Club and Rotary International (for 20 years), Hospice of Naples, Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts of America, and Quest for Kids, and
