## House Resolution

A resolution remembering and honoring former Florida State University President Dr. Bernard F. Sliger.

WHEREAS, Florida State University President Emeritus Dr. Bernard F. Sliger, who served as the university's tenth president, died on October 10, 2007, at 83 years of age, and

WHEREAS, a native of Trout Creek, Michigan, Dr. Sliger held three degrees from Michigan State University, bachelor's, master's, and doctorate degrees in economics, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sliger's educational career included 19 years as an economics professor and administrator at Louisiana State University and 4 years as Florida State University's executive vice president and chief academic officer, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sliger was one of Florida State University's most outstanding presidents who, with his unique combination of intelligence and enthusiasm, promoted higher academic standards and the growth of each faculty member, staff member, and student, and

WHEREAS, during Dr. Sliger's tenure as president of Florida State University, from 1977 to 1991 and on an interim basis in 1993 and 1994, student enrollment increased by nearly one-third, the university was awarded the National High Magnetic Field Laboratory and acquired three supercomputers, an engineering school was restored there in conjunction with Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University, and the university became the ninth member of the Atlantic Coast Conference, and
