1 2 An act for the relief of Alan Jerome Crotzer; providing an 3 appropriation to compensate Alan Jerome Crotzer for wrongful imprisonment and for being a victim of a 4 miscarriage of justice; directing the Chief Financial 5 Officer to draw a warrant; requiring the purchase of an 6 7 annuity; providing for the waiver of specified tuition and 8 fees; providing conditions for payment; providing 9 legislative intent; providing an effective date. 10 WHEREAS, in 1982, Alan Jerome Crotzer was convicted in 11 Hillsborough County, Florida, of rape, robbery, and kidnapping 12 and was sentenced to 130 years in prison, and 13 WHEREAS, Alan Jerome Crotzer may also be known as Allen 14 Jerome Crotzer in the criminal pleadings of this case, and 15 16 WHEREAS, after serving more than 24 and 1/2 years in prison, during which time he diligently maintained his 17 innocence, Alan Jerome Crotzer has been fully exonerated through 18 19 DNA tests, and WHEREAS, an order of the circuit court, entered on the 20 motion of the state attorney, has judicially established the 21 fact that Alan Jerome Crotzer should not have been incarcerated 22 since he was innocent of the crimes for which he was prosecuted, 23 24 and 25 WHEREAS, DNA testing of evidence has irrefutably excluded 26 Alan Jerome Crotzer as the person who committed the crimes for 27 which he was convicted, and
