> An act relating to failure to redeliver hired vehicles; amending s. 817.52, F.S.; providing that a photo of the person hiring a vehicle is not required in order to report the failure to redeliver that hired vehicle in violation of a specified provision; requiring the entry of reports of such failures in specified reporting systems; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 817.52, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
817.52 Obtaining vehicles with intent to defraud, failing to return hired vehicle, or tampering with mileage device of hired vehicle.--
(3) FAILURE TO REDELIVER HIRED VEHICLE.--Whoever, after hiring a motor vehicle under an agreement to redeliver the same to the person letting such motor vehicle or his or her agent, at the termination of the period for which it was let, shall, without the consent of such person or persons and with intent to defraud, abandon, or willfully refuse to redeliver such vehicle as agreed commits shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. A photo of the person hiring the vehicle shall not be required in order to report the failure to redeliver a hired vehicle under this subsection. A report under this subsection shall be accepted by a law enforcement agency without a photo of the person hiring the vehicle and shall be entered
