19 If Whenever, in any health insurance claim form, an (2) insured specifically authorizes payment of benefits directly to 20 21 any recognized hospital, physician, or dentist, in accordance 22 with the provisions of the policy, the insurer shall make such payment to the designated provider of such services, unless 23 24 otherwise provided in the insurance contract. The insurance 25 contract may not prohibit, and claims forms must provide an 26 option for, the payment of benefits directly to a licensed 27 hospital, physician, or dentist for care provided pursuant to s. 28 395.1041. The insurer may require the person who provided the 29 services to retain and make available upon request a written attestation of assignment of benefits. Such attestation assigning 30 benefits may be transferred to the insurer in electronic form. 31 32 Payment to the provider from the insurer may not be more than the 33 amount that the insurer would otherwise have paid without the 34 assignment.
