## Senate Amendment (with directory and title amendments)

Between line(s) 391 and 392,

If the law enforcement officer takes the child into custody, that officer shall:

- (a) Release the child to:
- 1. The parent or legal custodian of the child;
- A responsible adult approved by the court when limited to temporary emergency situations;
- 3. A responsible adult relative who shall be given priority consideration over a nonrelative placement when this is in the best interests of the child; or
- 4. The adoptive parent of the child's sibling, if such sibling was previously adopted, who shall be given priority



consideration over a nonrelative placement if it is in the best interest of the child to do so; or

- 5.4. A responsible adult approved by the department; or
- (b) Deliver the child to an authorized agent of the department, stating the facts by reason of which the child was taken into custody and sufficient information to establish probable cause that the child is abandoned, abused, or neglected, or otherwise dependent.

26 27 For cases involving allegations of abandonment, abuse, or 28 neglect, or other dependency cases, within 3 days after such

release or within 3 days after delivering the child to an authorized agent of the department, the law enforcement officer who took the child into custody shall make a full written report
