19	the term "acquired" means the acquisition of title to the
20	property; however, a subsequent transfer of the property to a
21	spouse, a surviving spouse in trust or free of trust, or a
22	revocable trust created for the benefit of the settlor does not
23	disqualify the site from financial assistance pursuant to s.
24	376.3071(5). Eligible sites shall be ranked in accordance with
25	s. 376.3071(5).
26	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
