7 preempted.--The adoption of residency distance limitations for
8 persons convicted of sexual offenses, including, but not limited
9 to, violations of s. 787.01, s. 787.02, s. 794.011, s. 800.04,
10 s. 827.071, or s. 847.0145, regardless of whether adjudication
11 has been withheld, is expressly preempted to the state on
12 October 1, 2008. The provisions of ss. 794.065, 947.1405, and
13 948.30 establishing such distance limitations supersede the
14 distance limitations included in any municipal or county
15 ordinances adopted on or after October 1, 2008. Any such
16 municipal or county ordinances that pertain to residential
