A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Department of Juvenile Justice; amending s. 984.01, F.S.; providing requirements for directing the funding and delivery of services of specified programs for children and families in need of services; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (2) of section 984.01, Florida Statutes, to read:

984.01 Purposes and intent; personnel standards and screening.--

(2) The Department of Juvenile Justice or the Department of Children and Family Services, as appropriate, may contract with the Federal Government, other state departments and agencies, county and municipal governments and agencies, public and private agencies, and private individuals and corporations in carrying out the purposes of, and the responsibilities established in, this chapter.

(d) The Department of Juvenile Justice shall ensure that an equitable percentage of all funding for nonresidential children and families in need of services programs be used to fund prevention resource programs in areas with a high volume of juvenile arrests. Additionally, the recipient of such funds shall demonstrate the inclusion of local nontraditional delinquency prevention service providers, such as grassroots
