A bill to be entitled

An act relating to a joint select committee of the Legislature; requiring the Legislature to establish a joint select committee to review methods of collecting court-related fees, service charges, costs, and fines used by circuit courts and county courts; providing for appointment of committee members; providing for designation of a chair and vice chair; requiring the committee to submit recommendations for a uniform statewide method for collecting such court-related fees, service charges, costs, and fines; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Legislature shall establish a joint select committee to review the methods currently used by each circuit court and county court in this state to collect court-related fees, service charges, costs, and fines. The committee shall consist of 13 members, of whom five shall be Senators appointed by the President of the Senate and eight shall be Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The committee chair and vice chair shall be designated jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The committee shall review for a period of 1 year methods used by the circuit courts and county courts in this state to collect court-related fees, service charges, costs, and fines, after which the committee

shall submit recommendations to the President of the Senate and
the Speaker of the House of Representatives as to an effective
uniform statewide method for collecting court-related fees,
service charges, costs, and fines to be mandated for all circuit
courts and county courts and clerks of such courts.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
