- (f) Any employer who prohibits a customer, employee, or invitee from possessing or keeping one or more of the following firearms locked inside a private motor vehicle:
- 1. A firearm that can accept a detachable magazine and has more than one of several specific military features, such as folding or telescoping stocks, protruding pistol grips, bayonet mounts, threaded muzzles or flash suppressors, barrel shrouds, or grenade launchers;
