94 <u>(j)(i)</u> "River Watershed Protection Plans" means the
95 Caloosahatchee River Watershed Protection Plan and the St. Lucie
96 River Watershed Protection Plan as defined in this subsection.

99 (4) SAVE OUR EVERGLADES TRUST FUND; FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR
100 DEPOSIT.--The following funds may be deposited into the Save Our
101 Everglades Trust Fund created by s. 373.472 to finance
102 implementation of the comprehensive plan, the Lake Okeechobee
103 Watershed Protection Plan, and the River Watershed Protection
104 Plans, and the Keys Wastewater Plan:

(a) Funds described in subsection (5).

(b) Federal funds appropriated by Congress for
implementation of the comprehensive plan, the Lake Okeechobee
Watershed Protection Plan, or the River Watershed Protection
Plans.

(c) Any additional funds appropriated by the Legislaturefor the purpose of implementing the comprehensive plan, the Lake

(e) Funds made available pursuant to s. 201.15 for debtservice for Everglades restoration bonds.

(6) DISTRIBUTIONS FROM SAVE OUR EVERGLADES TRUST FUND. --

Except as provided in paragraphs (d) and (e) and for 122 (a) funds appropriated for debt service, the department shall 123 distribute funds in the Save Our Everglades Trust Fund to the 124 125 district in accordance with a legislative appropriation and s. 373.026(8)(b) and (c). Distribution of funds to the district 126 127 from the Save Our Everglades Trust Fund shall be equally matched 128 by the cumulative contributions from the district by fiscal year 129 2019-2020 by providing funding or credits toward project 130 components. The dollar value of in-kind project design and construction work by the district in furtherance of the 131 132 comprehensive plan and existing interest in public lands needed 133 for a project component are credits towards the district's 134 contributions.

(b) The department shall distribute funds in the Save Our
Everglades Trust Fund to the district in accordance with a
legislative appropriation for debt service for Everglades
restoration bonds.

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139 To the extent that funds are available, the department (C) 140 may reserve a minimum of \$10 million annually from the Save Our Everglades Trust Fund for the purpose of implementation of the 141 142 River Watershed Protection Plans within the Northern Everglades 143 as identified in s. 373.4595. Distribution of funds from the 144 Save Our Everglades Trust Fund for the implementation of the 145 River Watershed Protection Plans shall be in accordance with paragraph (a) and shall be equally matched by the district and 146 147 Lee and Martin Counties by fiscal year 2019-2020 by providing 148 funding or credits toward project components. The dollar value 149 of in-kind project design and construction work by the district 150 or the counties in furtherance of the River Watershed Protection Plans and existing interest in public lands needed for a project 151 152 component are credits towards the district's and counties' contributions. 153

154 (d) Subject to a specific appropriation to the Department 155 of Agriculture and Consumer Services for the purpose of 156 implementing agricultural nonpoint source controls as identified 157 in s. 373.4595 or the legislatively ratified Lake Okeechobee Watershed Protection Plan and the River Watershed Protection 158 159 Plans, and upon written request by the Department of Agriculture 160 and Consumer Services for the transfer, the department shall 161 transfer an amount equal to such specific appropriation from the Save Our Everglades Trust Fund to the Department of Agriculture 162 and Consumer Services General Inspection Trust Fund. All 163 interest earned on the investment of funds transferred from the 164 Save Our Everglades Trust Fund to the General Inspection Trust 165

168	(e) Subject to specific appropriation, the department			
169	shall use moneys from the Save Our Everglades Trust Fund to fund

173	projects and expenditure of appropriated funds by the local
