To bring about such 20 21 retention, the salaries for full-time instructional personnel at 22 the school shall be increased annually to the average of comparable salaries, based upon academic qualifications and 23 years of experience, in the school districts of Clay County, 24 Putnam County, St. Johns County, and Flagler County.
